Case review team analyzed 3 intimate partner homicide cases and has 3 more potential cases on the horizon. Numerous strengths and challenges have been identified, and agencies are implementing changes.



Collaboration with Whatcom County courts to improve access to justice for survivors in civil and family law cases

Court personnel and advocates met in fall 2023 to implement changes to decrease barriers for survivors in civil court, particularly for those with language access needs. The SA/DV Commission, DVSAS, LAW Advocates, and Whatcom County District and Superior Courts are submitting a grant to the US Dept of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women to do this work together in a more comprehensive and coordinated way.
