Case reviews of intimate partner violence cases to identify strengths and gaps in community response

The case review team analyzed 3 intimate partner homicide cases in 2023 and has 3 more cases on the horizon for 2024. Numerous strengths and challenges have been identified, and agencies are implementing changes.

Enhance understanding of and interventions for criminalized survivors

Commission staff hosted a networking session for DVSAS advocates and public defenders in 2023. In March 2024, training was provided for the Blaine Police Department. Currently, we have started developing a flow chart to describe the criminal legal process for criminalized survivors. (Note: Two of the cases reviewed in 2023 involved criminalized survivors.)
